Policy Statement

Cherry Blossom Nursery and Preschool maintains the highest possible standard of security to our premises to ensure the safety of the children in our care

Please note, this Policy is read alongside 'Shared Premises'

Procedures

- All staff are DBS checked.
- Children are always supervised by no less than two staff - this depends on ages and numbers of children.
 - Two adults are always on the premises when children are in.
 - Our risk assessments are reviewed regularly.
- Systems are in place so that our children arrive and depart safely, the times are recorded.
- The arrival and departures of staff, students, bank staff, visitors and volunteers are also noted and recorded.
- Our practice and systems prevent children from leaving our premises unattended.
 - Our systems prevent unauthorized access to our premises.
- We have opening and closing checks to ensure the security and safety of the premises.
- Health and safety checks are carried out frequently by management and all staff are aware of their responsibility to report any health and safety concerns where the children's safety may be at risk, i.e doors, gates, fences, windows.
